

TOURNAMENT GUIDELINES

- BOOKING GUARANTEES:** Any group hosting an outing at Firethorne Country Club must attach a \$1,000 deposit or reserve tee times with a credit card, with a signed outing contract to guarantee the selected day and time. Management reserves the right to cancel any booking without proper deposit. Group is responsible for a billable guaranteed number of player's 5 days in advance of the event. Player roster and pairings are required 4 days in advance.
- CANCELLATIONS:** Any event cancelled with less than 120 days notice will be subject to loss of the deposit.
- RAINOUTS:** Every attempt will be made to reschedule an event in case of a rainout. If the event is not possible to reschedule, then no penalty will apply. Firethorne Country Club will solely determine if the golf course is unfit for play.
- FACILITY DAMAGE:** Any damage to the golf course, golf carts or related facilities will be charged to the outing host. Damage will be charged at the cost of labor and materials.
- DRESS CODE:** Outing representatives are responsible for informing all participants of the proper dress code.
- Men ~ Shirts with collars and sleeves, no denim, no sleeveless shirts and shorts must be Bermuda length.
 - Women ~ Skirts, slacks, golf shorts, mid-length shorts, blouses and sleeveless tops with a minimum of 3' of material covering the shoulder are considered appropriate.
 - Not permitted ~ Tank tops, T-shirts, fishnet tops, halter-tops, bathing suits, jams, sweats, tennis dresses, athletic shorts or cut-offs.
 - Shoes ~ Soft Spikes Shoes required.
- GOLF CARTS:** Use of golf carts is included in the price and is required. No spectator carts will be allowed unless approved by management and are billed to the group. Players are expected to abide by all cart regulations in effect the day of the event.
- PACE OF PLAY:** Firethorne Country Club expects a group not to exceed 15 minutes per hole (maximum 4 hours and 30 minutes per 18 holes). Firethorne Country Club reserves the right to monitor the pace and take any necessary steps to maintain this pace.
- COOLERS:** Personal coolers are not permitted at anytime.
- START TIMES:** All outings will start promptly at the scheduled time.

FIRETHORNES RESPONSIBILITIES TO GOLF OUTING

GOLF STAFF WILL:

- prepare pairings list and rule sheet
- prepare golf car signs
- prepare scorecards
- greet and load participant's bags
- prepare the practice range for the event
- prepare the scoreboard and score the event
- registration tables and chairs will be staged outside the golf shop with trash receptacles.
- provide beverage coolers at the turn between hole #9 and Hole # 10
- provide (2) gas powered utility vehicles for roaming beverage carts (any volunteer who drives a beverage car must be 21 years of age).

- must provide volunteers to hang any signage or banners
- must provide volunteers to place and pick-up any proximity markers or special event signage on the golf course at least two hours prior to the event and immediately after completion
- must not use stakes for signage without prior approval from the golf course superintendent
- must inform participants of Firethornes dress code and prohibition of metal spikes
- charity will notify Firethorne if at he number of participants exceeds 128 player field maximum two weeks prior to event to assure additional golf cars are available
- charity will keep a master list (provided by the golf shop) at registration and inform the golf shop of any name, pairing or handicap changes immediately after the beginning of play
